“Galley Recipes”

Breakfast Potatoes on the Grill

- 10 Pre-Baked Potatoes
 3 sticks of Butter
 Cavendars' Greek Seasoning
 Velveeta Cheese
 Sour Cream

Cut potatoes into bite size chunks and place into a foil roasting pan.

Slice up the butter and mix in. Add seasonings, cover pan with foil and put on grill.

When potatoes are heated, add cheese and sour cream. Heat until cheese is melted.

(Bake potatoes at home in foil wrap. Leave wrapped and take refrigerated to boat.)

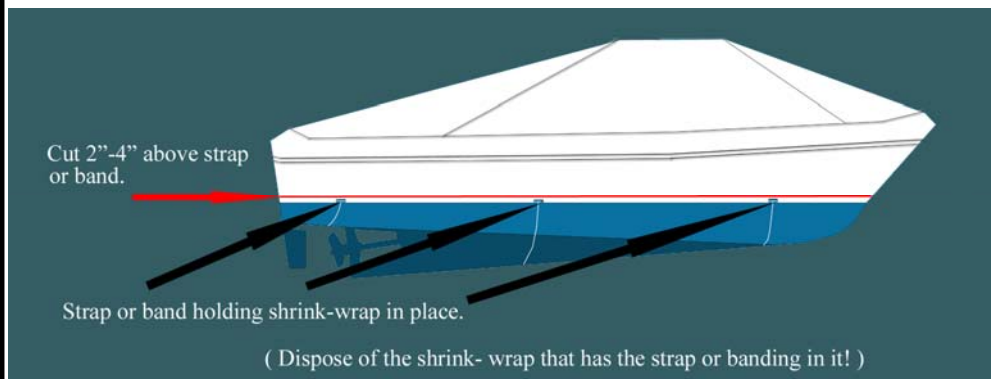

“Notes from the Service Desk”

When removing the shrink wrap, first cut the shrink wrap around the belly of the boat just above where the plastic is melted together (about 6 inches above bottom of shrink wrap). Just cut the plastic and not the string. This will allow you to remove the plastic from the boat with no string or banding buckles attached. **Shrink wrap plastic should slide right off, but be careful around antennas & anchor lights.** Using a letter opener style razor blade will protect the hull from being scratched.



When you are done with the shrink wrap plastic, roll up and place under bow of boat. Place any wood or upright supports and padding on top and HLM will collect the shrink wrap and supports. **DO NOT PLACE IN GARBAGE DUMPSTERS.**

The shrink wrap string, banding buckles and bottom 6 inches of shrink wrap can be put in the garbage dumpsters.

New Key Card System

Cards Available April 10th.

HLM will have a new key card system installed by April. The new system will allow restricted or unrestricted access to restrooms, guard gate, pool house and ramp with one card, which is a proximity card, you just hold it close to reader. The new system will also allow us to see who opened the door and when. We can also deny access to individual card holders. If cards are lost and turned in, we will know who's card it is and we can return it or if the card is lost or not returned we can deny access and the card is no longer good.

Each card will require a \$20.00 deposit.

If you still have a pool key card (white front/grey back) you can return it for a \$30.00 credit toward the new card or cards.

Are you planning a boat trip to Canada? You will need a pass port and if you do not want to stop at a video phone upon entering back into US waters you will need an I-68.

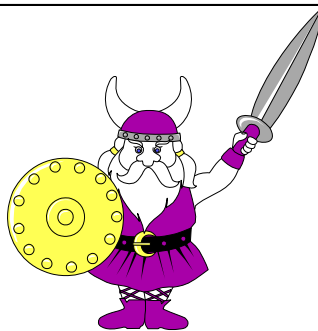

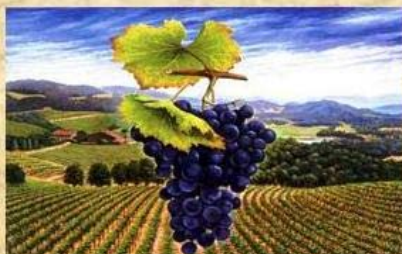
