## “Galley Recipes”

### LYC Chili Cook Off Winner Don's Zinfandel and Buck Venison Chili

- 2 lb ground venison
- 2 lb Jimmy Dean Original Sausage
- 2 medium Vidalia Onions, chopped
- 1 medium red onion, chopped
- 3 jalapeno peppers, seeded and chopped
- 1 red bell pepper, seeded and chopped
- 1 yellow bell pepper, seeded and chopped
- 2 Tb Ancho chili pepper powder
- 1 green pepper, seeded and chopped
- 1 24-oz can diced tomatoes
- 1 24-oz can plum tomatoes
- 3 cans Bush's dark kidney beans
- 1 10-oz can Ro-tel diced tomatoes with habaneros, “hot”



- 1 Tb cumin
- 1 Tb salt (optional)
- 1 Tb cinnamon
- 1 Tb black pepper
- ¼ cup honey
- 1 Tb molasses
- 1 Tb paprika
- 3 stalks celery, chopped
- 4 cloves garlic, minced
- ¼ cup balsamic vinegar
- 8 oz mushrooms, chopped
- 4 Tb chili powder (regular)
- 1 bottle Yeungling Beer (dark)
- ½ cup Don's homemade zinfandel wine

1. Brown meat in large, heavy pot.
2. Remove meat from pot. Drain most of the fat, leaving a few tablespoons to start step three. Set aside meat.
3. Cook onions, peppers and celery in same pot for 5-10 minutes, until soft, scraping frequently to loosen brown bits from pan.
4. Add garlic and vinegar. Cook about 3 minutes.
5. Add chili powders, cumin, paprika, salt, pepper and cinnamon. Stir these spices into vegetables and cook another 3-5 minutes.
6. Add venison and sausage and mushrooms. Make sure everything is coated with the spices – stir well!
7. Add honey, molasses, beer, wine and tomatoes.
8. Stir well again. Bring to boil. Reduce heat and simmer on low, uncovered for 1 hour.
9. Add beans and simmer an additional 20 minutes or so.
10. Taste and, if desired, adjust seasoning to your liking.

## ATTENTION BOATERS

Hoses with hose bibs using an A. S. S. E. No. 1011 vacuum breaker (pictured on the left) that are used for filling water holding tanks or for washing surfaces of the watercraft, **SHALL BE STORED OUT OF THE WATER AND DISCONNECTED FROM THE HOSE BIB WHEN NOT IN USE.**

**You may have the 1052 vacuum breaker (pictured on right) installed so that you can hook directly to the boat and leave the hose connected, for a one time fee of \$38.00.**

**During upcoming inspections by the health department, any slip holder in violation will automatically be charged the \$38.00 fee and the 1011 will be replaced with a 1052 vacuum breaker.**

## “Notes from the Service Desk”

This spring we have had several boats damaged by wildlife, ours included. We would like to bring to your attention that some insurance companies cover such claims with restrictions and some don't. This might be a good time to review your policy to see if you have coverage and if so with what restrictions.

### BATTERY CHARGERS

Leaving the boat charging system on for a long period of time is not good for the batteries. Over time the charger can cook the electrolyte and decrease the battery life. When you are not on the boat using the 12 volt system you should leave your charger off and turn your battery switch off as long as your bilge pump is wired direct to the battery.

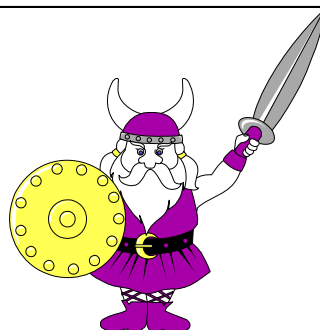
