### Spring Letter 2019

Dear Captain,

**Huron Lagoons Marina and our sister facility Holiday Harbor Marina were recognized at the 3rd Annual Ohio Marina Conference on February 20, 2019 for reaching GOLD status as an Ohio Clean Marina.**

We achieved gold status by continuing to voluntarily adopt Best Management Practices (BMP), incorporate management measures to address areas of greatest pollution potential on our property and a commitment to protecting the environment.

One of the **BMP's** is recycling the shrink wrap. Only the shrink wrap plastic is recyclable. If you are not keeping your shrink wrap and plan on removing the shrink wrap from the boat yourself, one of the ways you can help us is by removing the shrink wrap nylon string from the plastic for disposal. The easiest way to do that is to cut the shrink wrap (using a razor blade letter opener) about 6-8 inches above the "belly strap" all the way around the boat. The shrink wrap plastic can then be easily pulled off the boat to be recycled. Then you can remove all the nylon string attached to the boat and to the wood supports. All of the nylon string and the cut off belly strap can be put in the garbage dumpster or balled up and put under the road end of the boat along with the rolled up shrink wrap plastic with any wood supports placed on top to prevent plastic from blowing away. The HLM yard crew will then come around and gather all materials. All shrink wrap left under the road end of the boat will be collected. If you are saving your shrink wrap, put your shrink wrap under the boat at the opposite end of the road. Also if you are not using a dustless sander when sanding your boat bottom, place the plastic under the boat bottom to help collect the sanding dust, which the sanding dust can then be put in the garbage dumpster.

Enclosed is the Spring Work Order. Keep in mind when scheduling your launch date that we do not launch boats on Sundays and that the yard crew will not start working Saturdays until April. Should you require any services before spring launch be sure to fill out the form and return ASAP. Service work is scheduled based on launch date and some service requires weeks of lead time before the launch date and weather plays a factor.

NOTE: HLM will not launch any boat that has an outstanding balance, unless your account balance is current. Dockage is due in full March 15th.

Power at the docks will be turned on mid to late March when we put the docks back in the water and the city water at the docks will not be turned on before mid-April or when we are sure there will not be an unexpected freeze. Should you require city water there are several hydrants throughout the marina. Three in D-slip, at the base of E-slip, back side of shop and on the hill side south end of the storage building. We do not recommend de-winterizing your boat before mid-April in case of an unexpected freeze, but we will launch boats as early as you want. Please advise if you plan to occupy your dock slip before April 10th. All docks should be ready to be occupied by then.

HLM Open House weekend is set for Saturday April 13th. Save on all marine accessories in stock and special ordered items. From bottom paint to cleaners, anchors to fenders, electronics and nick knacks. We will have a distributor representative on hand to answer any marine accessory question you might have. Everything in the store will be on sale and for you early birds that want to get started when the weather breaks we will have Open House pricing starting March 1st and ending April 15th.

Saturday May 11th HLM will host the ODNR Safe Boating Class which is free at the HLM Pool Complex. This class is good for the entire family ages 12 years and up. Mandatory Boater Education is required for any person born on or after 1/1/82 who will operate a powerboat with more than 10 hp. To sign up go to this link on our website.

On May 18th, from 9am to 2 pm, the Berea Power Squadron will be performing courtesy boat safety inspections (highly recommended). Watch for them walking through the marina if you would like an inspection. Keep in mind that boats with a current safety stickers will not get pulled over for a routine inspection.

May 25th will be the Blessing of the Fleet. Laguna Yacht Club members Nancy & Mike Young has arranged for Father Marek Zisnovsky to bless the fleet at Holiday Harbor Marina and Huron Lagoons Marina. To participate stand at the water end of the dock or boat to be blessed. Father Zisnovsky will be coming up the slips by boat starting at 11:00 am on D & E slip then progressing through HHM & C, B & M-slip at HLM.

However any outside contractor, with your prior notification to marina office, must check in at the office before performing any work and provide to marina the necessary documentation for insurance coverage and state and federal permits. Failure to do so, unauthorized personnel will be asked to leave the premises immediately.
