

HOLIDAY HARBOR MARINA SWIMMING POOL RULES

General Rules

1. **HHM** swimming pool is operated by the **Holiday Harbor Marina** for the enjoyment of its Dockers and guests in social and recreational activities. Your support of all the services offered by HHM makes this facility possible, so please support your local marina.
2. HHM swimming pool rules are enforced to enable members and their guests to safely enjoy the pool activities. Activities are planned throughout the season in an effort to enhance the feeling of community and friendship within the marina.
3. Swimming pool attendants have complete discretionary power to enforce the written pool complex rules. There is no room for debate by the members or their guests. They may exclude or expel members or guests in the event they deem it necessary in order to protect the mental or physical well being of the participants present at the swimming pool. Appeals may be made at a later date to the marina manager.
4. No employee shall be threatened, reprimanded or punished by any member or guest. Any concern regarding an employee's performance should be directed to the marina manager.
5. HHM and staff are not liable for injury or damage from carelessness or negligence by members or guests. They are not responsible for damage or loss of personal property.
6. Members are expected to report any rule violations by others to HHM management.

Swimming Pool Availability

1. The swimming pool will be open Memorial Day through Labor Day.
2. Pool hours are 10:00 am to sunset. **You must leave the swimming pool area by sunset.**
3. **There is no lifeguard on duty.**
 - Admission is by key card only and must be a HHM member in good standing.
 - Children age 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult 18 years or older.
 - Admission without a parent, a child must be at least 13 years of age and a current member and have an issued key card.
 - Pool is open only to HHM members in good standing and their guest.
 - Persons inside the pool may not open the gate to anyone other than their own family members or guests.

Swimming Pool Key Cards

1. HHM members are required to have a signed "Pool Complex Rules" form on file with HHM, which is obtained from the marina office before a key card is issued.
2. Each key card requires a \$20.00 deposit which will be refunded when card is returned at the time you are no longer docked at Holiday Harbor Marina.
3. Lost or stolen cards must be reported to office so the key card can be deactivated.
4. A \$20.00 credit will be given to the assigned key card holder for lost key cards that are returned to the marina office.

Parent Responsibilities

1. Parents will be held responsible for the conduct of their children whether they are present at the swimming pool or not.
2. Parents will supervise their children in the swimming pool at all times.
3. Parents will be responsible for their children's use of the swimming pool.

After Hours

1. Persons in the swimming pool area after the swimming pool has been closed will be charged a fine of \$100.00 and all swimming pool privileges will be suspended. This is considered trespassing and the police will be called to investigate the disturbance.

Rules of Conduct

1. Courtesy and Politeness will be observed at all times. No loud or profane language or boisterous conduct will be permitted. Boisterous conduct is defined as overly active conduct that is dangerous to others. No pushing or throwing persons into the swimming pool. No running. No diving.
2. Persons with communicable infections, colds, runny noses, skin rashes, skin diseases, pink eye, may not enter the swimming pool.
3. Members are responsible for cleaning their tanning oil off the pool furniture when they leave the pool area so others don't get it all over their clothes.
4. No pushing, scuffling, splashing or rough play is permitted in the pool.
5. **Glass containers are not permitted within the fenced in swimming pool deck area.**
6. Food and drinks must be kept at least five (5) feet away from the pool. No food and drinks in the pool.

7. An adult must accompany non-swimmer children into the water, which is too short to stand in the swimming pool. The use of flotation devices does not circumvent this rule.
8. There is no smoking allowed within the pool complex area, to protect the health and safety of the children and for the comfort of those who do not smoke.
9. No one under the age 21 may possess or consume alcoholic beverages.
10. No illegal drugs may be brought into the swimming pool area.
11. Radios may be played with the volume limited to a six-foot diameter. Earphones are encouraged.
12. Sunflower seeds and gum are not permitted in pool area.
13. Towels, rocks, hard balls, water balloons, large inner tubes and flotation devices, food, drinks and cigars or cigarettes are not allowed in the water.
14. Swimsuits designed for swimming and appropriate to a community swimming pool are appropriate water apparel. Other types of clothing are not permitted in the water. Street clothes and under garments are not allowed.
15. Please dispose of all trash in the garbage cans.
16. Please use barbecues in the designated areas.
17. No petition and no solicitation of funds.
18. No animals are allowed in the swimming pool area.
19. No strollers, bikes, roller blades, scooters, or skateboards are allowed in the swimming pool area. Keep bikes clear of the swimming pool entrance.
20. No jumping on lounges or standing on chairs, tables or any other furniture.
21. Shoes or sandals are to be worn while walking from the parking lot to the pool so that only clean feet enter the pool.

Rules for Guests

1. Guests must be accompanied by a HHM member. The member must remain at the swimming pool at all times in order to supervise and be accountable for the guests' actions.
2. Guests are limited to 1 guest per day for each family's members. During crowded times guests may be further limited or denied access to the swimming pool area.

Penalties

1. Minor: This is defined as a swimming pool conduct infractions. Examples include roughhousing, shouting profanities, diving into the pool, etc.
 - First time: Polite Warning
 - Second time: Stronger warning and time out.
 - Third time: Exclusion from the swimming pool for an extended time.
2. Serious: Loss of all swimming pool privileges for a year.
 - Alcohol, smoking, or illegal use of drugs by minors.
 - Illegal use of drugs by adults.
 - Serious threats to members, guests or employees safety.
 - Admitting unauthorized guests.
 - Use of the swimming pool after the swimming pool area is closed.
 - Destruction of swimming pool property, gross littering or vandalism.

Note: Swimming pool may be video monitored for compliance of the rules.
